SUBJECT: Business Process Improvement Services Request for Proposal Program Year 2016/17 Recommendation.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Workforce Development Board (WDB) Executive Committee approve the recommendation submitted by the Request for Proposal reviewers to award Instructional Access Inc./Rapid 3D Manufacturing an agreement to provide Business Process Improvement Services from October 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017.

BACKGROUND: In support of the WDB's Strategic Plan, the Economic Development Agency/Workforce Development Division released a Request for Proposal (RFP) on June 20, 2016 to procure for Business Process Improvement Services (non-manufacturing) for program year 2016/17. Business Process Improvement Services include assistance with lay-off aversion, jobretention services, strategic and financial planning, quality assurance, energy efficiency, IT systems and human resource development. Two proposals were received before the closing date on July 20, 2016. Upon reviewing the proposals, Instructional Access/Rapid 3D Manufacturing bidder was determined to meet the specifications in the RFP. The other bidder did not meet the minimum specifications as outlined in the RFP.
