SUBJECT: Workforce Investment Act (WIA) Formula and American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) Youth Funding Recommendations for the operation of the Summer Work Experience and Year Round Youth Programs for Program Year 2010/11.

RECOMMENDED MOTION: That the Workforce Investment Board (WIB) Executive Committee approve the 2010 Summer Work Experience and 2010/2011 Year Round Youth Program funding recommendations and authorize the Director of Riverside County Economic Development Agency (EDA), Workforce Division, or her designee, to negotiate and execute agreements within 10 percent of the funding recommendations.

BACKGROUND: Riverside County currently has Youth Opportunity Centers (YOC) located in Hemet, Lake Elsinore, Rubidoux, Indio and Perris. The procurement term for the operations of the YOCs ends June 30, 2010. Additionally, the procurement waiver from the State of California allowing Local Workforce Investment Areas the ability to allocate American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds to existing youth service providers ended September 30, 2009.

On February 11, 2010, the Economic Development Agency issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) to solicit service providers to operate the five YOCs. The service providers would oversee the 2010 ARRA Summer Work Experience and the WIA Year Round Youth Programs for Program Year 2010/11. The procurement term is valid for three years and subsequent funding for Program Years 2011/12 and 2012/13 may be increased or decreased depending on funding availability and performance.

The EDA received one proposal for each of the following YOCs: Indio, Perris and Lake Elsinore. In addition two proposals were received for the Rubidoux and Hemet YOCs. The proposals' information are as follows:
