SUBJECT: That the Workforce Development Board (WDB) Executive Committee approve the Riverside County Integrated Service Delivery Initiative Local Plan as presented

RECOMMENDATION: That the WDB Executive Committee approve the California Integrated Service Delivery Initiative Local Plan as presented.

BACKGROUND: The Riverside County LWIA will pilot one of 12 learning labs in the State developing an Integrated Service Delivery Model. The learning lab integration will include the Workforce Investment and Wagner-Peyser system, staff and processes. Once implemented, the learning lab will create a local workforce system that is skill based moving each One-Stop Career Resource customer through a common set of value added integrated services designed to increase their employability, job retention and advancement.

Economic Development Agency (EDA) Workforce and Employment Development Department (EDD) Job Service are responsible for piloting the design and implementing the local integrated service delivery system in accordance with the State's draft policy framework. The integration plan reflects the parameters of the State's draft policy on integrated service delivery. The plan includes an explanation of how the design elements of the State policy framework and plan components will be modeled for each area of integration and overall development of the emerging delivery system. Submission of the plan is due to the state Employment Development Department Workforce Services Branch by February 29, 2008.

EDA and EDD since 2004 have worked together to implement Continuous Quality Improvement through its Steering Committee, Center Operations Alignment Team and other teams. These workgroups have recommended and implemented changes in workforce activities to improve services to business and job seekers.
